Time for a romantic getaway for just the two of you? Whether you prefer sitting beside a country lake, an urban oasis or lounging on a tropical beach, we have ten great suggestions for your next vacation:

1. Le Petite Hotel, Montreal:

Le Petite Hotel is housed in 19th-century buildings and located in the historic, charming city center of Old Montreal, Quebec, Canada: (877) 530-0360. Visiting Montreal is like a quick trip to France. Though French is the city's official language, albeit with a distinctly Québécois accent, the city is bi-lingual and everyone does speak English. Explore the Old Quarter for fantastic French food or use the public Bixi bikes to ride along the canal and go antiquing. On Friday and Saturday nights, head for Deux Pierrots, - a rocking cabaret and sports bar located at 104 Rue Saint-Paul East, in the old city. Be sure to make advance reservations as this place fills up quickly. I promise, you will have a great time even if you don't understand a word of French. Porter Air from Newark offers service on par with private airlines. Alternatively, it is a ten and a half hour ride by Amtrak or a six and a half hour drive. 2. Mayflower Grace, Washington, CT. (Formerly Mayflower Inn & Spa), Washington, CT

This quaint Yankee Inn is nestled in the tiny town of Washington near the Western edge of Connecticut, roughly a two-hour drive from Westchester. Couples adore the spacious guest rooms appointed in classic New England style, including spectacular four-poster canopied beds with plump goose feather pillows. Some rooms have fireplaces and deep soaking tubs. Their spa is spectacular in every way, offering a wide range of massages and great yoga classes. Yonkers Is Going Hollywood

The Yonkers Film Office is a busy place: film days are up 61% since Mayor Spano began an aggressive outreach to production companies three years ago. The campaign has been successful, bringing \$250,000 in new revenue to the city, according to Christina Gilmartin, Director of Communications. In an effort to make the city more "film friendly," the Mayor has eliminated film permit fees for the use of city property and created a new website (film.yonkers.com) to assist location scouts and producers with "one stop shopping," fast tracking any necessary permits and coordinating city services to expedite the process. "All of us at Law and Order SVU want to express our deepest gratitude. I have never had such a positive experience filming in a town in 23 years," reads a producer's testimonial on the website.

Typically, the city only receives 1-2 weeks of notice prior to a film shoot, said Gilmartin. Melissa Goldberg, Director of the Film Yonkers Office, serves as the liaison for location scouts. The fourth largest city in the state, Yonkers encompasses an area of 20.3 square miles so there are plenty of sites to choose from. Yonkers offers great vistas of the Palisades, the Hudson River and streets lined with a variety of architectural styles. Proximity to Manhattan makes it easy for actors and production companies based in the city to shoot here and go home at night.

Yonkers City Hall and the

Courtroom appear often on Law and Order SVU. The ceremonial courtroom at City Hall is a popular backdrop and has appeared in commercials for Dr. Pepper, and one for Sprint starring Kevin Durant, as well as in many TV shows and movies. Martha Stewart recently wrote an editorial piece about Untermyer Garden in her Martha Stewart Living Magazine, noted Gilmartin, and the Garden is also featured in the wedding scene for Ricki and the Flash, directed by Jonathan Demme, which will be released in August of 2015. The film stars Meryl Streep as a rocker, her daughter Mamie Gummer, Kevin Klein, Rick Springfield and Audra McDonald.

As a result of the burgeoning Yonkers Film industry, the city now boasts a sound stage on Tuckahoe Road and an annual Film Festival. Look closely at popular shows and you just might recognize a familiar Yonkers neighborhood, park or public building. The Yonkers Hudson Line Train Station has been featured in Boardwalk Empire and Van der Donck Park was the setting of a recent episode of Black List.

Other productions that have filmed in Yonkers include the movies: Still Alice starring Academy Award winner Julianne Moore; Adderall Diaries starring James Franco, Amber Heard and Christian Slater; God's Pocket, the late Philip Seymour Hoffman's last film; A Most Violent Year starring Oscar Issac; and the HBO mini-series Show Me A Hero, also starring Oscar

Issac. TV shows filmed here include The Following, Elementary and Gotham.

Yonkers Stage/Greenwich Productions is just 20 minutes from Manhattan, offering the fully decked 32,000 sq. ft. soundstage, a 30,000 sq. ft. annex, dressing rooms, parking, storage, cold storage, shop space for set construction, an easy access drive-in stage, Reel Snow and production offices. A long list of movies have filmed here, including: Wall Street Two directed by Oliver Stone, starring Michael Douglas; The Bounty, starring Jennifer Aniston; Taking Woodstock directed by Ang Lee; Notorious Big produced by Sean Coombs, Doubt, starring Meryl Streep; The Number 13 starring Mickey

Rourke; I Am Legend starring Will Smith; American Gangster directed by Ridley Scott starring Russell Crowe; My Super Ex-Girlfriend. Directed by Ivan Reitman starring Uma Thurman; Freedomland directed by Joe Roth starring Samuel L. Jackson and Julianne Moore; Hitch Starring Will Smith; The Manchurian Candidate directed by Jonathan Demme starring Denzel Washington; Mona Lisa Smile starring Julia Roberts; Maid in Manhattan starring Jennifer Lopez; Riding in Cars with Boys directed by Penny Marshall starring Drew Barrymore; Rollerball directed by John McTiernan starring Chris Klein; Finding Forester directed by Gus van Zandt starring Sean Connery and The Thomas Crowne Affair starring Peirce Brosnan and Rene Russo.

Sometimes, a casting call goes out to the home team: the majority of the extras for the HBO film Show Me A Hero were all Yonkers residents, said Gilmartin. Yonkers residents also appeared as extras in God's Pocket.

As residents become increasingly blasé about walking round movie shoots while going about their daily errands, the Film Office continues their efforts to grow this industry and build revenue for the city. "The Mayor's Office of Film and Photography wants production companies to know that the city "is committed to helping assure the success of your shoot and providing for a quality production experience," said Gilmartin.
